

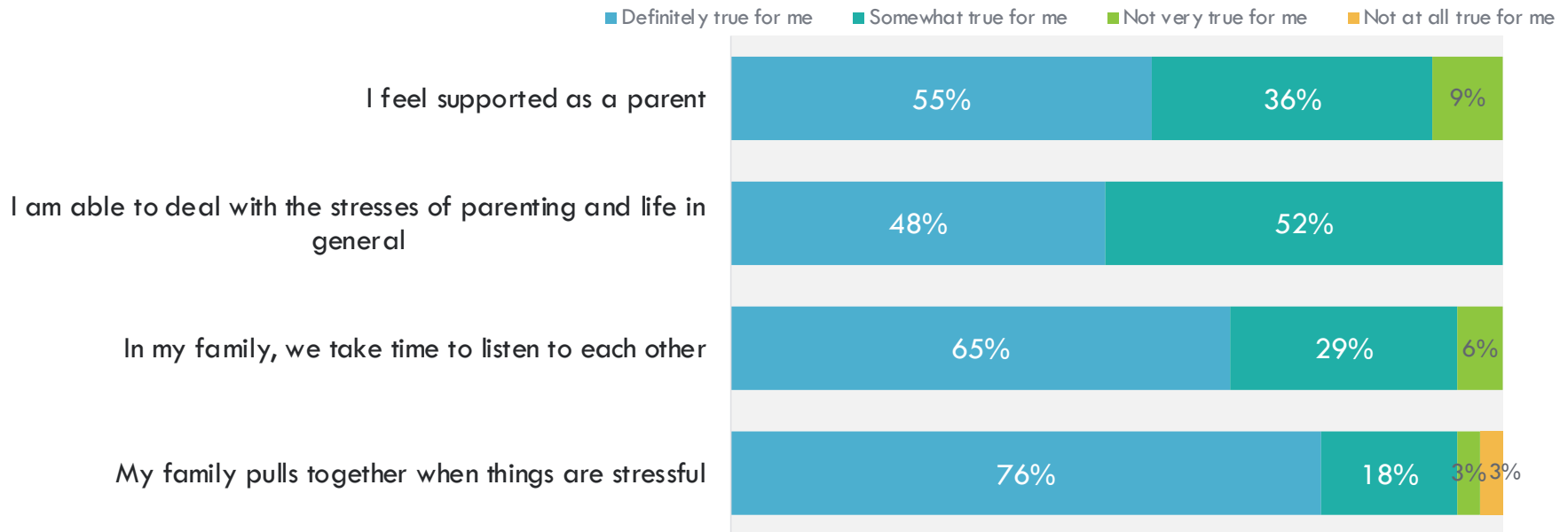

Protective Factors Amongst Families Served by First 5 Tehama (2021)

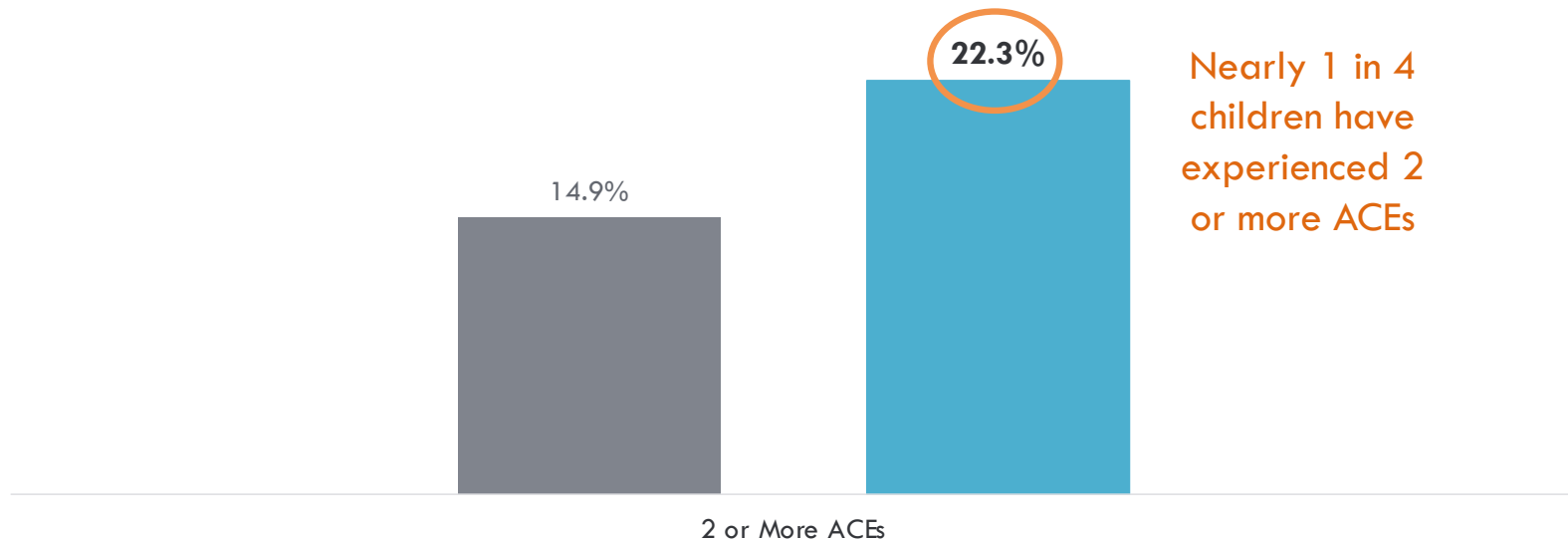

Percentage of Children 0-17 Experiencing ACEs (2016-2019)

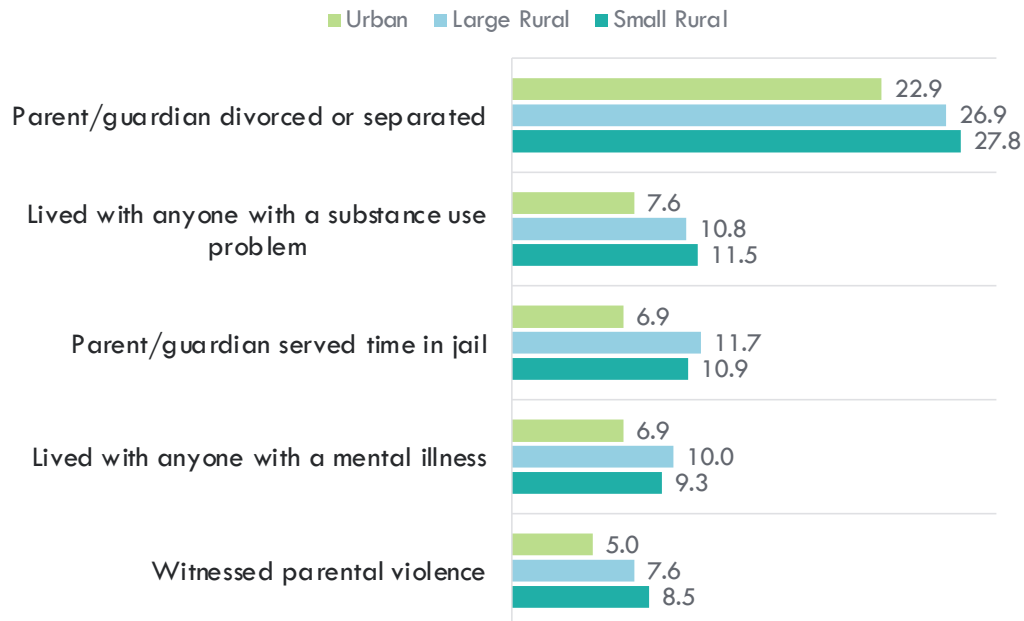
■ Region (Tehama, Colusa, Glenn, Trinity Counties) ■ California

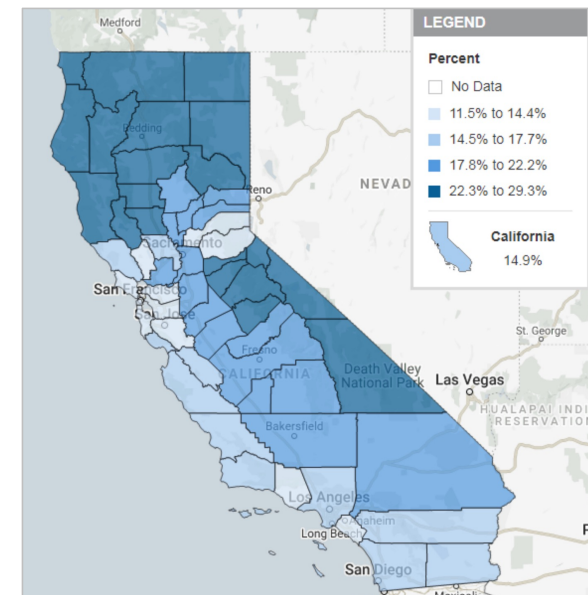
ACEs – Rural vs. Urban Context

Prevalence of ACEs by Rural or Urban Residency (2017-18)



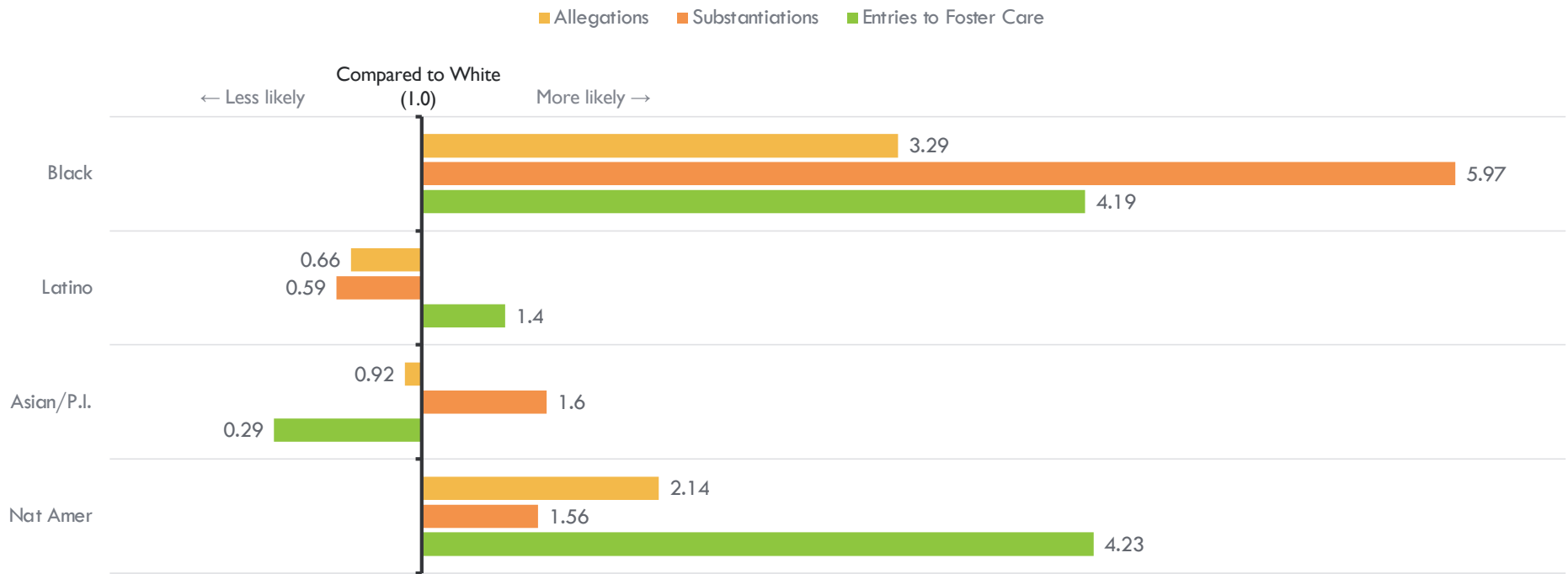
