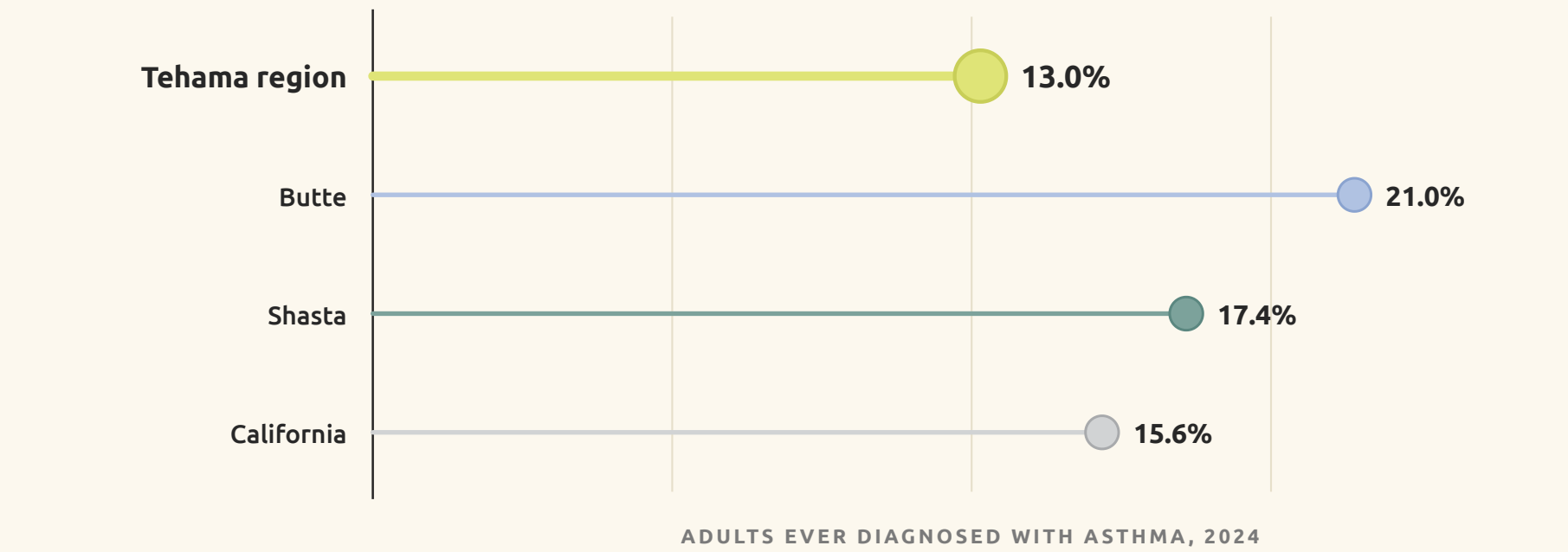

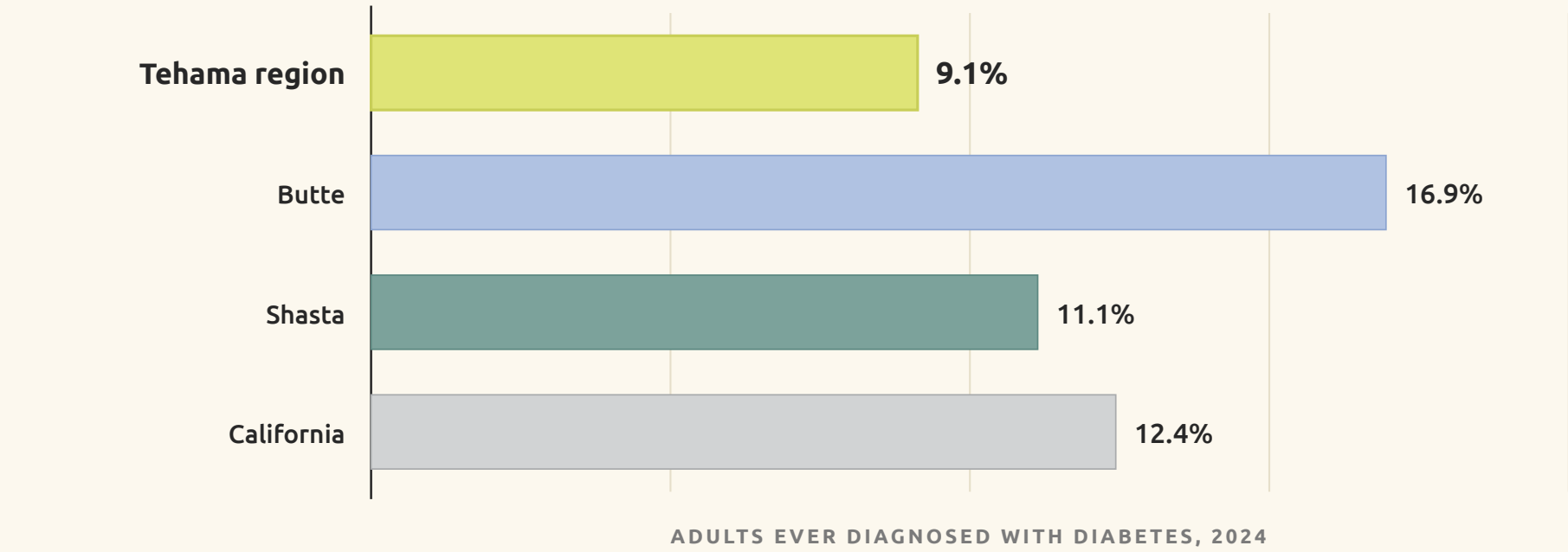

Adults ever diagnosed with diabetes



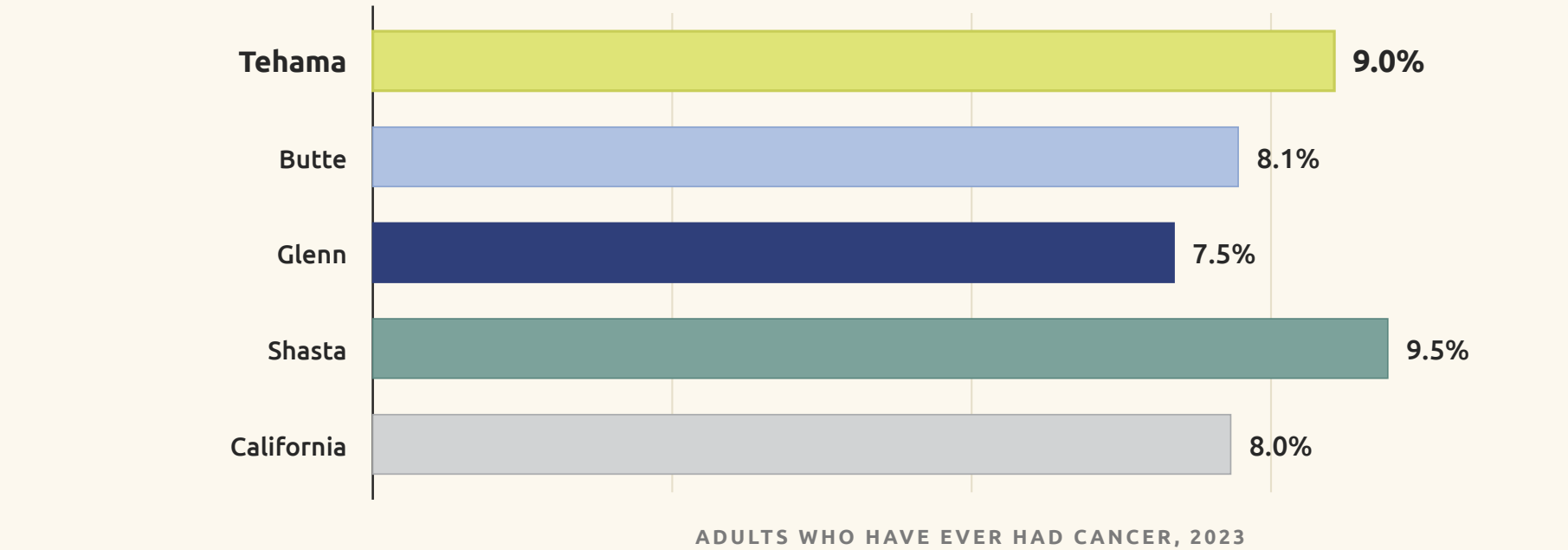
WHY THIS MATTERS
Asthma drives missed school, missed work, and avoidable ED visits. Its prevalence in a community is closely tied to housing quality, air quality, and poverty, meaning high rates are rarely just a health story.

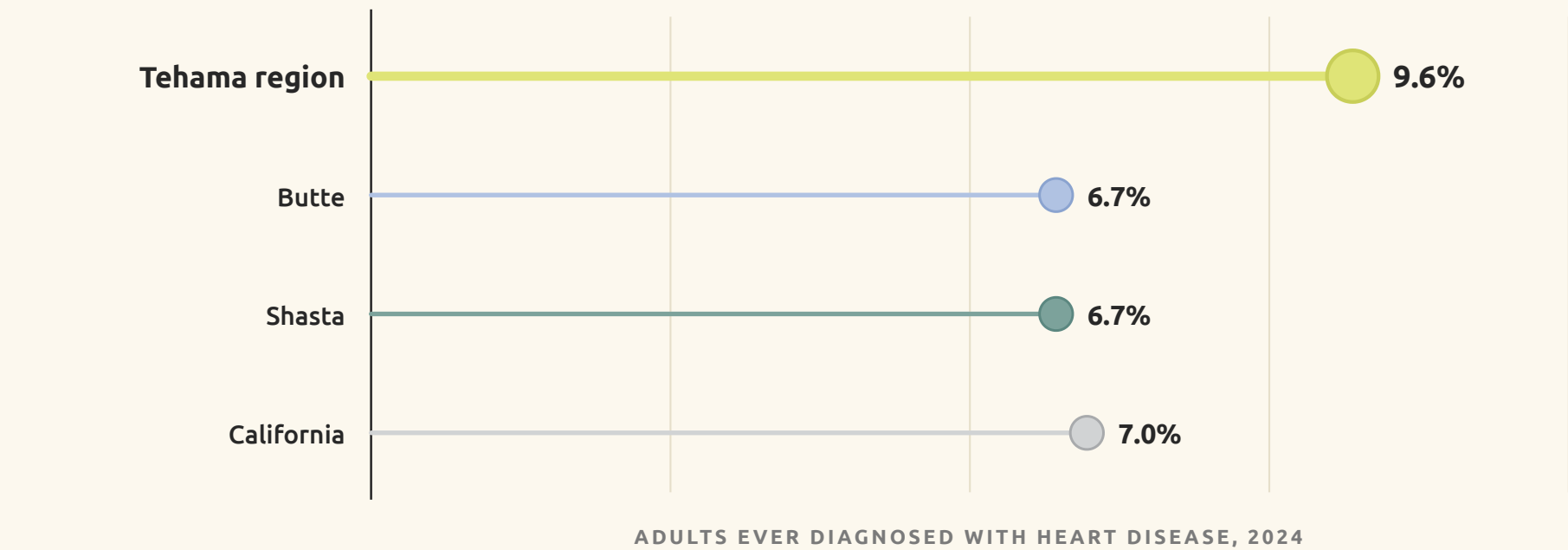
WHY THIS MATTERS
Diabetes prevalence anchors planning for primary-care capacity and chronic-disease management programs. In rural communities with limited specialist access and transportation barriers, even well-diagnosed patients can struggle to manage the condition effectively.

Adults ever diagnosed with heart disease



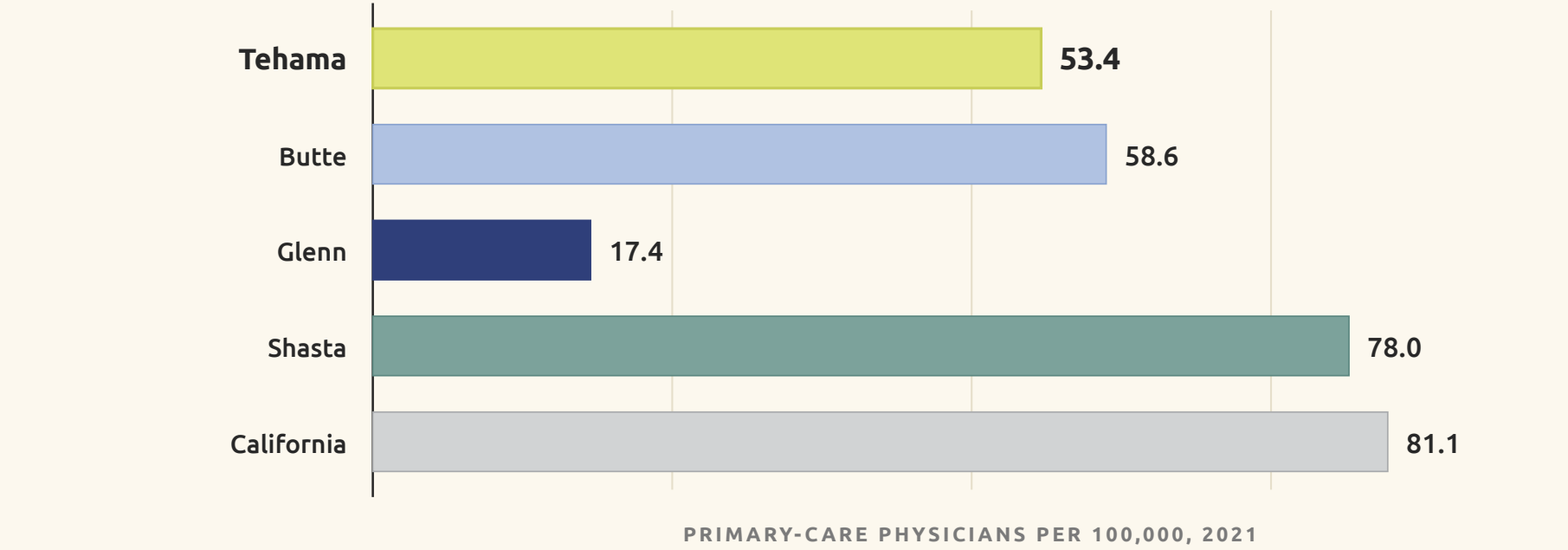
WHY THIS MATTERS
Cancer prevalence reflects both screening reach (more cases caught) and population aging, both of which are relevant to primary-care load.

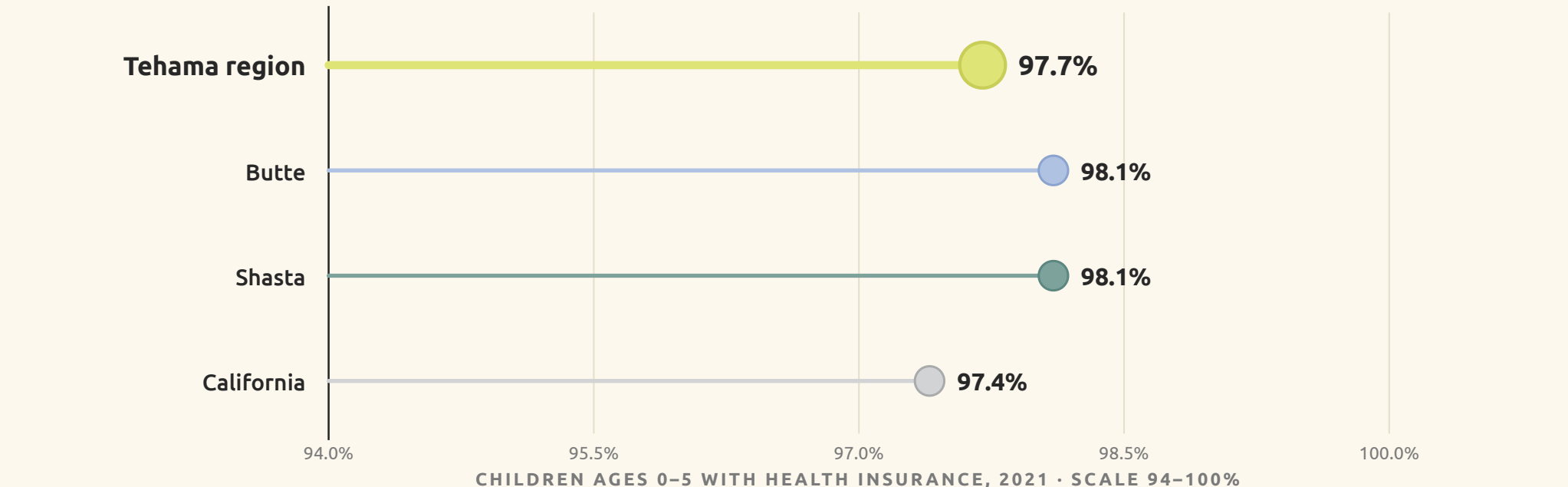
WHY THIS MATTERS
Heart disease prevalence is closely tied to behavioral risk factors (diet, activity, smoking) and to access to ongoing primary care. Increasingly, research also points to chronic stress – poverty, trauma, housing instability – as a driver.

WHY THIS MATTERS
Workforce density is the upstream constraint on every prevalence metric on this poster – fewer providers means longer waits and more travel. When primary care is hard to access, people delay care, conditions worsen, and the burden shifts to emergency departments and community-based providers.

WHY THIS MATTERS
Health coverage in the first five years of life is less about insurance than about access to the developmental screenings, well-child visits, and early interventions that can alter a child’s entire trajectory.
